## P A C K I N G   L I S T

The most common question with our multi-day tours is where to leave your luggage. We recommend checking it in with your hotel until your return. The Inca Rail/Peru Rail trains allow you to carry on luggage up to 7K (15lbs) per person. You are also allowed a small backpack which we recommend you bring for the day you tour through Machu Picchu. We recommend only bringing the necessary items in your smallest luggage and having your day pack for items such as a light jacket/poncho, snacks, camera, etc. Like in Cusco, the remaining luggage can be left in Aguas Calientes hotel until our return.
